2012 Events in and around Rye

Rye always has something for the visitor to do. Hardly surprising given the town's close association with the sea and surrounding farms, food features heavily in Rye's major festivals.

Late February stages the popular Rye Bay Scallop Week. Local restaurants band together to offer the finest selection of scallop-based dishes in celebration of the locally caught shellfish.

Early in August, the Maritime Festival meets on the Strand Quay, Rye, to celebrate the town's rich nautical heritage. In previous years, the event has included lifeboat demonstrations, maritime exhibitions, live entertainment and raft races.

The well established Rye Arts Festival runs for two weeks every September. The festival is a showcase for internationally renowned musicians, writers and artists to gather and perform.
